Hello September and impending Fall season. We had a lot of fun in August, and squeezed out as much learning as we could!

I was very sad to say goodbye to Lincoln, Mason, Penny, Ellis, Kaynen, and Corah! I am grateful that I still get to see all your smiling faces across the wall in Ms. Mickey's class.

Welcome Back, Spencer B. I am excited to get to know you better and welcome you to all our crazy adventures!

Leo M. has transitioned to our class also! Welcome, Leo. You are already a bright spot in my day, and are adjusting swimmingly.

In September, we will be switching gears. We will start the month off discussing 'Farm'. The kids will have fun focusing on a different animal each day. We will incorporate fun centers such as, pigs in the 'Mud', building farms with blocks, counting animals in math, and feeding animals in the kitchen. Be on the lookout for artwork, as well as the continued use of parent-guided questions!

The artist of the month is Georgia O'Keefe. The class will watch a child-friendly video about her, and then we will make our very own replicas of her 1958 painting 'Ladder to the Moon', using teal paint for the background and popsicle sticks to make the ladder.

While discussing the country of the month, France, we will have fun exploring different ways to construct the Eiffel Tower using vanilla wafers. straws, and toothpicks. We will explore French culture with our creative cooking making crepes! YUMMY!

We will close the month out with introducing Fall! Yay! We will discuss a variety of areas as we do so. We will learn about why leaves fall and change colors. We will go on a Fall scavenger hunt, an complete crafts based on the things that we find in nature. There are a myriad of books to explore such as 'Leaf Man', by Lois Ehlert, and 'Goodbye Summer, Hello Autumn', by Kenard Park. We will discuss apples and go 'apple picking' outside., as well as conducting and apple science experience. We will soak cut-up apples in different liquids, such as, coffee, milk, water, and vinegar, to test which liquid best prevents browning. We

will also conduct a taste test to determine whether green apples taste better than red!

Our student of the month is Lainey K. Lainey is very smart and has the best outfits! Lainey enjoys playing with her friends and is learning to write her name. Congrats Lainey!

MISS MICKEY—PRESCHOOL 4'S

Hello Fall! Welcome to September! We learned so much about dinosaurs in August. We really enjoyed learning about how big some of the dinosaurs were! We were so excited when our dinosaurs finally hatched out of their eggs!

In September, we will do a little study on farm animals. We will learn what animals live on a farm, what they eat, and how they help us (cognitive/science). We will learn what farmers do. In our math center, we'll create patterns as well as counting and grouping animals. In our dramatic play area, we will make a pretend farm. We will be building a pretend chicken coop—this will be fun!

The last two weeks of September, we will learn about Fall and apples. We will discuss what happens in fall and how the leaves change color. We will also investigate an apple and learn the parts and the cycle of an apple.

We will be starting our monthly study of an artist again this month. This month, our first artist will be Mary Cassatt. We will be creating our own teapot pictures.

We will do a lesson on our country of the month, France. We will create our own French flags. Then we will create our own Eiffel Tower using straws. We will even try building one with blocks. We will also be learning some words in French.





SEPTEMBER 2020 HEALTH & CHILD DEVELOPMENTAL NEWS THIS MONTH

9 COMMON PARENTING MISTAKES MADE WITH TODDLERS & PRESCHOOLERS

- 1. Being inconsistent—Children do best when they know what to expect. Establish and keep routines as much as possible.
- 2. Too much family time—Family time is great, but sometimes children need that one on one with their parent.
- 3. Offering too much help—Parents who offer too much help can sabotage their child's ability to become self-reliant. Teach children to tolerate struggles, and be their biggest cheerleader.
- 4. Talking too much—Your child does not care what your explanations are. Establish a consequence and stick with it. End of story.
- 5. Serving only kiddie food—Most children are picky eaters, but as the adult, we need to encourage them to try new foods. Encourage "No thank you" bites!
 - 6. Getting rid of the crib too early—Cribs promote good sleep habits. A toddler bed should only be given when the child starts climbing out of the crib.
- 7. Starting potty training too early—Some parents begin potty training when THEY think it's time. This can lead to an unnecessary power struggle. Children learn to use the toilet when they are ready.
 - 8. Allowing too much screen time—You know this is true! Too much screen time can lead to troubles learning later on.
- 9. Trying to stop a temper tantrum—Yes, it's embarrassing, but the fact is, the best thing to do is let the child finish the tantrum, then simply move on.
